1 BY-LAWS OF RECLAMMATION DISTRICT CREATED BY ORDER OF THE BOARD  
2 OF SUPERVISORS ON THE 6th DAY OF JULY, 1909.  
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5 The undersigned landowners owning more than the ma-  
6 jority of the acreage of the lands of that certain Reclamation  
7 District, <sup>No. 799</sup> situate in Contra Costa County, State of California,  
8 the formation for which the undersigned petitioned the said  
9 Board of Supervisors to approve and form, and which petition was  
10 by said Board of Supervisors approved on the 6th day of July,  
11 1909, hereby adopt the following By-Laws for the government and  
12 control of said District, to wit:

13 Said Board of Trustees shall after their election pro-  
14 vide for an office to be kept in or near said District, in which  
15 shall be kept the books and records of said District, and may  
16 from time to time change the place of said office as in the  
17 judgment of said Board may seem proper, the convenience of the  
18 landowners and Trustees of said District considered.

19 The time for regular meetings of said Board is hereby  
20 fixed for the *first* ~~Tuesday~~ day of each month, at the hour of *one*  
21 o'clock. *P.M.*

22 Special meetings of the Board of Trustees may be call-  
23 ed at any time by the President or any two members of said  
24 Board.

25 NOTICE OF MEETINGS.

26 No notice shall be required of the holding of any

27 regular meetings.

28           Two days notice by mail shall be given by the Sec-  
29 retary or President of all Special Meetings; in lieu thereof,  
30 personal notice of not less than twelve hours given by the  
Secretary or President to the members of the Board shall be

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1 sufficient notice of such meeting; provided, however, no notice  
 2 shall be required when there are present at any meeting a full  
 3 Board, said presence being construed to be a waiver of notice.

4 The Trustees shall employ a Secretary, who shall keep  
 5 a correct record of all proceedings, and proper books of account.

6 These By-Laws may be amended at any time by the sig-  
 7 natures of the owners of the majority of the acreage of the  
 8 lands of the District.

 10 Adopted this *23<sup>rd</sup>* day of July, 1909, by the  
 11 signatures hereto of landowners holding more than the majority  
 12 in acreage of the lands of the District.
